**Autopsy results showed Dawud Gordy died from multiple gunshot wounds. Atlantic County Medical Examiner Dr. Hydow Park:**

**There were three penetrating gunshot wounds and one perforating wound. The three penetrating ones entered through the top of the left shoulder and two entered through the left upper back. The gunshot wound that perforated Dawud Gordy's body damaged the victim's lung, liver and stomach. The three shots that penetrated his body damaged his ribs, lung and aorta.**

MAYS LANDING – Authorities are investigating the fatal shooting of a man found dead in a car in Atlantic City Wednesday night, Atlantic County Prosecutor Ted Housel stated.

Atlantic City police received a call for shots fired at 6:35 p.m. Police arrived at a vacant lot across from 702 North Michigan Avenue and discovered the victim Dawud Gordy, 23, of Martin Luther King Boulevard in Atlantic City. The Prosecutor's Office Major Crimes Unit was called to assist and is actively investigating.
