MAYS LANDING – A Hamilton Township woman was arrested and charged with credit card theft and theft of more than \$600, First Assistant Prosecutor Murray Talasnik announced Wednesday.

On Sept. 22, 2008 while employed at a restaurant that is located on the Black Horse Pike, Dalynn White obtained information from a customer's ATM card, Prosecutor's Office Detective Edwin Cintron stated. White, 30, of the Woodland Condominiums, then allegedly utilized the card information for her own personal use.

The victim, who resides in Galloway Township, brought the matter to the attention of local police. Galloway Township police notified the Prosecutor's Office Financial Crimes Unit of the alleged incidents in November of 2008.

White was arrested by members of the Financial Crimes Unit at the Galloway Township Police Department on Feb. 10.

Both third-degree charges carry a maximum of up to five years in prison.

Galloway Township Municipal Court Judge Christopher Brown set White's bail at \$20,000, of which White must post 10 percent to be released pending further legal proceedings.

*****These charges are merely an accusation and not proof of guilt. In all criminal cases, a charged defendant is presumed innocent unless and until proven guilty.**
