MAYS LANDING – Authorities are seeking a suspect who fatally shot an Atlantic City man and injured a Pleasantville woman outside a restaurant early Friday morning, Atlantic County Prosecutor Ted Housel stated.

At 1:04 a.m. Friday Pleasantville Police received a 911 call regarding a fight outside Wash's Inn located off of Route 9 in Pleasantville. Sgt. Christopher Leeds and Officer John Payne responded. Upon arrival they heard gunshots and found a 33-year-old man who suffered a gunshot wound to the head. The victim was transported to the AtlantiCare Regional Medical Center, City Campus, where he was pronounced dead less than an hour later. The victim's identity is not being released pending notification of next of kin. Tameka Cutler, 39, of Pleasantville, suffered a gunshot wound to the leg. She was transported to the City Campus where she was treated and released. Atlantic County Prosecutor's Office Detective Joseph Rauch and Pleasantville Police Detective Len Jackson are conducting the investigation.
