MAYS LANDING – A man found fatally shot outside a Pleasantville restaurant Friday morning has been identified as Charles Hough, 33, of Atlantic City, Atlantic County Prosecutor Ted Housel stated Tuesday night.

Authorities would not release the name of the victim pending notification of next of kin, which was made a short while ago tonight.

Pleasantville Police received a 911 call at 1:04 a.m. Friday for a report of a fight outside Wash 's Inn, an establishment located off Route 9 in Pleasantville. Sgt. Christopher Leeds and Officer John Payne responded. Upon arrival they heard gunshots and found Hough with a gunshot wound to the head. Hough was transported to the AtlantiCare Regional Medical Center , City Campus, where he was pronounced dead less than an hour later.

Tameka Cutler, 39, of Pleasantville, suffered a gunshot wound to the leg and was transported to the City Campus where she was treated and released.

Atlantic County Prosecutor's Office Detective Joseph Rauch and Pleasantville Police Detective Len Jackson are conducting the investigation.
