MAYS LANDING – An Atlantic City man was gunned down early this morning in an alleyway near the Covenant House in Atlantic City. Authorities are seeking suspects, Atlantic County Prosecutor Ted Housel stated.

David Nesbitt, 32, left his 1100 block home on Adriatic Avenue on his way to a convenience store at around 12:30 a.m. when an unknown suspect shot him numerous times. Atlantic City Police Detectives and members of the Prosecutor's Office Major Crimes Unit responded to 237 N. South Carolina Avenue in Atlantic City for a report of shots fired. Atlantic County Medical Examiner Dr. Hydow Park pronounced Nesbitt dead at the scene.

Dr. Park performed an autopsy on the victim this afternoon and determined he died of multiple gunshot wounds.

Prosecutor Housel would not comment on a possible motive for the shooting.
