MAYS LANDING – A man was gunned down early this morning in Atlantic City. Authorities are seeking suspects, Atlantic County Prosecutor Ted Housel stated.

Marcus Brown, 25, of 1406 Cedar Court in Atlantic City, was found dead on a sidewalk across the street from Seashore Produce in the 1300 block of Reading Avenue, Prosecutor Housel said.

The Atlantic City Police Department received a 911 call at 1:39 a.m. for a report of shots fired. Officers responded to Reading Avenue and discovered Brown. Atlantic County Medical Examiner Dr. Hydow Park pronounced Brown dead at the scene. Next of kin was notified.

Dr. Park performed an autopsy Monday afternoon and determined Brown died from multiple gunshot wounds.

Prosecutor Housel would not comment on a possible motive for the shooting.
