MAYS LANDING – An Atlantic City man was arrested on Wednesday for allegedly selling false government documents, Atlantic County Prosecutor Ted Housel announced today.

Francisco Marin, 37, of 2611 Monterey Avenue in Atlantic City, was arrested and charged by Prosecutor's Office Detective Edwin Cintron with selling false government documents, a second degree crime. Marin was also charged with operating a motor vehicle without a valid driver's license.

Prosecutor's Office Financial Crimes Unit detectives, along with Atlantic City police officers, executed a search warrant at Marin's residence on Wednesday, where they seized computers and electronic devices used to manufacture false identification documents.

Superior Court Judge Bernard E DeLury Jr. set Marin's bail Wednesday night at \$50,000 cash or bond. Marin was then transported to the Atlantic County Justice Facility. His initial court appearance is scheduled for 9 a.m. on July 23.

The arrest was the result of a yearlong cooperative effort between the Prosecutor's Office Financial Crimes Unit, the Atlantic City and Somers Point police departments and the US Department of Homeland Security Immigration and Customs Enforcement.

**\*\*\*These charges are merely an accusation and not proof of guilt. In all criminal cases, a charged defendant is presumed innocent until and unless proven guilty.**
