MAYS LANDING – One man was fatally shot and three others wounded when gunshots erupted in a parking lot in the 1300 block of Adriatic Avenue in Atlantic City early this morning, Atlantic County Prosecutor Ted Housel announced.

Shadiy Dixon, 20, from Atlantic City, died of his injuries. Dixon, a father of two, and several other individuals were gathered in the Moe's Chicken parking lot at 12:30 a.m. when the incident occurred. Carlton Williams, 23, of Atlantic City, Shaheed Little, 20, of Atlantic City and Egg Harbor City, and a 17-year-old juvenile male, of Atlantic City suffered gunshot wounds, according to First Assistant Prosecutor Murray Talasnik. Williams, who was shot in the abdomen, and the teen, who was shot in the left thigh, remain in an area hospital. Little was shot in the right calf. He was treated and released.

Members of the Prosecutor's Office Major Crimes Unit and Atlantic City police responded are investigating.

Prosecutor Housel would not comment on a motive for the shootings.
