**MAYS LANDING** – Authorities executed simultaneous search warrants at 1113 South New Road and 44 East Lindley Avenue in Pleasantville yesterday morning and recovered two handguns, cocaine and approximately \$3,200 in cash, Atlantic County Prosecutor Ted Housel announced today.

Daniel Williams, 20, of Pleasantville, was arrested and charged with possession of controlled dangerous substances, possession with intent to distribute, possession with intent to distribute within 500 feet of a public zone, possession of a defaced firearm and possession of a handgun during the commission of a CDS offense.

Joshua Nixon, 20, of Pleasantville, was arrested and charged with possession of controlled dangerous substances, possession with intent to distribute and possession of a handgun during the commission of a CDS offense.

Andy Nelson, 50, of Pleasantville, was arrested and charged with possession of controlled dangerous substances, possession with intent to distribute and possession with intent to distribute within 500 feet of a public zone.

The three men were transported to the Atlantic County Justice Facility in lieu of bail.

The arrests were a result of an investigation by the Atlantic County Prosecutor's Office Shooting Response Team and the Northfield Police Department. Prosecutor's Office Detective Kevin Ruga and Northfield Police Detective Mike Buccafurni conducted the investigation with assistance from the Pleasantville Police Department, Egg Harbor City Police Department, Federal Bureau of Investigation and Atlantic County Emergency Response Team.
