**MAYS LANDING** – An Atlantic City man was convicted today of possession of cocaine, possession of cocaine with the intent to distribute, resisting arrest and obstruction and faces up to 10 years in prison at sentencing, Atlantic County Prosecutor Ted Housel announced.

Kali Sloan, 27, must serve three to five years of the prison term imposed prior to being eligible for parole. The defendant was convicted after a few hours of jury deliberations this afternoon. On Jan. 1, 2008 Sloan was in the area of 800 Virginia Avenue in Atlantic City when he was attempted to make a drug deal and was observed by two Atlantic City detectives. When the officers approached Sloan and attempted to take him into custody a brief struggle ensued. Sloan was taken into custody a short while later, according to Assistant Prosecutor Seth Levy.

Judge Isman revoked bail at the State's request. Sloan will be sentenced on March 5.
