**MAYS LANDING** – An Atlantic County Grand Jury indicted an Atlantic City man today on murder and three weapons offenses, in connection with the June 8 shooting death of another Atlantic City man, Atlantic County Prosecutor Ted Housel announced.

It is alleged that Robert Ingram, 26, gunned down Marcus Brown, 25, across the street from Seashore Produce in the 1300 block of Reading Avenue. The Atlantic City Police Department received a 911 call for shots fired at 1:39 a.m. the morning of the incident. Officers responded to the location where they discovered Brown, of 1406 Cedar Court, dead at the scene. Atlantic County Medical Examiner Dr. Hydow Park performed Brown's autopsy and determined the victim died of multiple gunshot wounds, Prosecutor Housel stated.

Assistant Prosecutor Tracey O'Brien presented the case to the Grand Jury this afternoon.

Ingram, of 3 South Iowa Ave., was arrested on Oct. 23 while already in custody at the Atlantic County Justice Facility on unrelated drug and weapons charges. He remains in the county jail in lieu of \$1 million bail, O'Brien stated.

Prosecutor's Office Major Crimes Unit Detective Patrick Snyder conducted the investigation with Atlantic City Detective Greg Ingram.

**\*\*\*The indictment is merely an accusation. The defendant is presumed innocent until proven guilty beyond a reasonable doubt.**
