MAYS LANDING— An Egg Harbor City man was arrested and charged Friday with second-degree aggravated arson in connection with a July 13, 2009 fire that left four families displaced, Atlantic County Prosecutor Ted Housel announced today.

Joseph Manzoni, 43, of 507 Atlantic Avenue, allegedly set a fire at an apartment building next door to his Egg Harbor City residence. A female resident was in the building at the time of the fire, put a cloth over her face and was able to escape uninjured, Egg Harbor City Detective Steven Hadley said.

Egg Harbor City Municipal Court Judge William Cappuccio set Manzoni's bail at \$75,000 full cash and Manzoni was transported to the Atlantic County Justice Facility in lieu of bail.

The arrest was a result of an investigation by Egg Harbor City Detective Hadley, Egg Harbor City Captain Rick Kramer and Prosecutor's Office Detective Justin Furman.

Second-degree arson carries a sentence of up to 10 years in prison subject to the provisions of the No Early Release Act.

**\*\*\*These charges are merely an accusation and not proof of guilt. In all criminal cases, a charged defendant is presumed innocent unless and until proven guilty.**
