AUTOPSY RESULTS:

Atlantic County Medical Examiner Dr. Hydow Park performed autopsies on Sept. 9 on both victims and determined they died of multiple gunshot wounds.

MAYS LANDING— Authorities are seeking a suspect or suspects in connection with a double shooting this evening in Atlantic City that left a woman and a man dead, Atlantic County Prosecutor Ted Housel announced.

Atlantic City police responded to 1309 Caspian Avenue at 5:43 p.m. for a report of a shooting. Upon arrival, they discovered a woman, identified as Jan Lynette Williams, 28, of the 1000 block of Brigantine Boulevard in Atlantic City, dead outside of the residence, of an apparent gunshot wound. The second victim, Marlon Thigpen, 25, of Atlantic City, was transported to the AtlantiCare Regional Medical Center, City Campus, where he died later of his injuries. Families of both victims have been notified, Prosecutor Housel stated.

Autopsies are scheduled for tomorrow morning.

The Prosecutor's Office Major Crimes Unit is conducting the investigation along with the assistance of the Atlantic City Police Department.
