MAYS LANDING– Authorities have confirmed the identity of a man gunned down in Atlantic City last week, but the victim's name will not be released until notification of next of kin has been made. Law Enforcement continue to search for a suspect or suspects, Atlantic County Prosecutor Ted Housel announced today.

Prosecutor Housel said that because the 22-year-old victim was a foreign national, it could take some time to locate and notify the family.

On Sept. 23 Atlantic City police responded to the corner of Connecticut Avenue and Arctic Avenue at 10:30 p.m. for a 911 report of a man lying in the street. Upon arrival, police discovered the victim suffering from a gunshot wound, Prosecutor Housel stated.

Emergency personnel transported the victim to the AtlantiCare Regional Medical Center, City Campus, where he was pronounced dead at 11:57 p.m., Prosecutor Housel said.

Atlantic County Medical Examiner Dr. Hydow Park performed an autopsy and determined the victim died of a gunshot wound to the abdomen, Prosecutor Housel said.
